Five Day Club

airport. Once through customs they loaded the bus and headed for Honey Camp lagoon. They got settled into their dorms and unloaded all their stuff. Bright and early the next day the work started.



Each day Cindy would take a few kids from the team into Orange Walk and conduct Child Evangelism Fellowship's "Five Day Clubs" for the children. A.V.B.S. type club with an intense emphasis on the Gospel message. The team participated in the singing and the games, and interacted with the children throughout the club.

We don't know what your opinions are about a team made up entirely of people between the ages of 10-13. But we can tell you they can accomplish so much. This is the start of their work project. To lay out, mix and pour sidewalks around the base. They also cleared stumps, built flower beds and a driveway curb, and repainted our entrance wall. Here is a list of what they accomplished as a team. They poured: 40 feet of flower bed curb, 372 feet of driveway curb, 381 feet of four foot wide sidewalks. And to do this they moved:

645 loads of concrete consisting of; 54,180 lbs. of gravel, 51,600 lbs. of sand, 12,255 lbs. of cement, and 15,480 lbs. of water. In the end they moved 133,515 lbs. of material in 14 six hour work days!



The dorms are empty. The base is quiet except for the rustle of the wind. We have our peace and quiet back. But the team is already being missed. They came into our lives and spent three and a half weeks with us. We all got to know each other a little bit better. It was nice to be able to work alongside these hard workers and teach them something they may never have had the opportunity to learn. We trust they also enjoyed their time here with us doing the work and learning from us and about us. In the end it is our desire and ministry to help people find a deeper and closer walk with the Lord Jesus Christ.

Hosting mission teams is an intricate aspect of our ministry here in Belize. We are always looking for churches, youth groups, or adult study groups that are interested in using our facility. We are set up to host up to 25 people comfortably. We are secluded and offer a great chance to slow down and hear the Lord.
