We arrived with pledged support of only \$200.00 per month. The Lord has touched people's hearts and we can gladly say that our support level has increased considerably since that time. However, we are still well below what is needed to live and minister in Belize. With our current monthly support we are at 50% of the amount we need. This amount is donated by nine faithful supporters, and we praise God for each one. The need for more monthly supporters is one reason we have decided to return to the U.S. at this time.
