In our last newsletter we stated that we have heard the Lord tell us with certainty that we are to be serving Him in Damongo, Ghana, West Africa. To that end we have been making the necessary preparations for our moving to Ghana in December, 2018. There are many things we must accomplish here to be able to leave and establish our ministry in Ghana.

- New passports... done.
- Ghana vísa... done.
- Ghana long term work permit... still working on this. Police report, health certificate, education certificates, and resumes are needed.
- Required vaccinations... done.
- Secure two smart phones... done.
- Purchase portable video projector for ministry... done.
- Upgrade laptop for ministry... done.
- Purchase airline tickets... not yet, but we have identified flight and airline.
- Necessary documents and vaccinations for Brodie (our dog)... not yet.
- Sell truck & RV... not yet as we will continue to live in the RV until December.
- Sell all possessions... started but some things are needed until December.
- Raise additional financial support... some new support has come in, but we still need additional monthly support.

Financial Support

It would also not be possible to serve those we are sent to help if we are doing something other than the ministry the Lord has asked us to do. Our time should be consumed doing the Lord's work.

We all also understand there are financial requirements to being alive on this earth. Everyone needs food, clothing, shelter, medicine, & transportation, just to name a few. The idea that serving in a developing country means lower living expenses just isn't true in most cases.

Small \$\$ Big Impact

We have heard from many people who tell us they just can't afford \$100.00 a month to help with the ministry.
