In our ministry here in Belize, we are often asked how to have a better life, more money, or good health. We try to steer the conversation to a relationship with Jesus Christ.

Just today a man asked me those very things. When I mentioned his walk with the Lord his reply was, "Yes I am a Christian. I tried that, and it didn't help. Why would the Lord do these things to me?" What do you say to comments like that?

We have come to realize so many people are not **serious** about their relationship with the Lord. It is a convenient and routine thing they do. It is not the whole of their life, or even their focus. They have more important things to do. They don't bother with the teachings of the New Testament saying they are too strict and outdated. Here is my favorite.... "I serve a God of love. He won't hold me to those teachings as long as I love Him."

We were recently doing some pre-marital counseling with a couple. We tried to get them to see they were not being *serious* with each other or with the Lord. Just going through the motions and wondering why their relationship was not where they wanted it. We strongly suggested they get *serious*, or quit trying. Since they truly wanted to be together they decided to get *serious* and do what it takes to make it work. In effect they will have to completely change their focus and commit everything they do to that relationship. We also told them that alone is not enough. You have to have the Lord in the middle of all your decisions.

I am sure everyone who considers themselves a Christian is very glad that God was **serious** about having a relationship with them. And was willing to do whatever was needed to make that relationship a reality.

"For God so loved the world, that He gave His only begotten Son, that whoever believes in Him should not perish, but have eternal life."
